

The Wyalusing Municipal Authority was established to oversee the day to day running of the water and sewer utilities in the Borough of Wyalusing. Although the Wyalusing Borough is the actual owner of the utilities, the Authority takes care of the maintenance, testing, and filing of proper paperwork with DEP, billing, and the removal of the sludge to the Northern Tier Solid Waste Authority in Burlington. To accommodate communication there is a Liaison between the Wyalusing Municipal Authority and the Wyalusing Borough who in most cases attends both the regular monthly meeting of the Wyalusing Municipal Authority and the Wyalusing Borough.

Any financial concerns such as budgets and rate changes must first be approved by the Wyalusing Borough before they can be adopted by the Wyalusing Municipal Authority.

At the present time, the rates for water and sewer are as follows:

Water\_\_\_\_\_seventeen dollars (\$17.00) for the first three thousand gallons of usage and .00275 cents per gallon thereafter.

Sewer\_\_\_\_\_twenty five dollars (\$25.00) flat rate.

Water Connection Fee\_\_\_\_\_five hundred dollars (\$500.00)

Sewer Connection Fee\_\_\_\_\_one thousand dollars (\$1000.00)

The rates listed above are figured on one EDU (equivalent dwelling unit). Therefore multi-dwelling units or industrial and institutional units would be charged hook-up fees calculated at how many EDU's each building would represent. For example, a ten unit apartment building's hook up fee would be ten times the hook-up rate of a single dwelling EDU.

The Wyalusing Municipal Authority meets the second Tuesday of every month at 7:00p.m. unless otherwise advertised. These meeting are open to the public.
