BOROUGH OF WYALUSING
ORDINANCE NO. 45 AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER NO. 45, WATER, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WYALUSING, COUNTY OF BRADFORD, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

The Borough of Wyalusing hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

Under PART 1, Public Water System, Section 101 Definitions, of the Code of the Borough of Wyalusing, hereby *deletes* the following:

CONSUMER – a person who, prior to, upon or after the effective date hereof, has contracted or shall contract for water service or a consumer unit and/or a person who, upon or after the effective date hereof, is receiving or shall receive water service for a consumer unit. For purposes of rate schedule, consumer is further defining as follows:

CONSUMER – a consumer who has a water meter larger than 5/8 inches in diameter or whose water consumption is greater than 300 gallons per day or 9,000 gallons per month.

RESIDENTIAL CONSUMER – a consumer who has a water meter of 5/8 inches in diameter or smaller and whose water consumption is 300 gallons per day or less or 9,000 gallons per month or less.

Under PART 1, Public Water System, Section 101 Definitions, of the Code of the Borough of Wyalusing, hereby adds the following:

CONSUMER – a person, organization, industrial or commercial entity, who, prior to, upon or after the effective date hereof, has contracted or shall contract for water service or a consumer unit and/or a person, organization, industrial or commercial entity, who, upon or after the effective date hereof, is receiving or shall receive water service for a consumer unit.

Under PART 1, Public Water System, Section 102. Rate Schedule, of the Code of the Borough of Wyalusing, hereby deletes the following:

B. Water Rates. Water usage shall be billed at the following rates:

- (1) Residential Consumer. Residential consumers shall be billed at the rate of \$17 for the first 3,000 gallons used per month and \$2 for each additional 1,000 gallons used per month.
- (2) Commercial Consumer. Commercial consumers shall be billed at the rate of \$30 for the first 3,000 gallons used per month and \$2 for each additional 1,000 gallons used per month.

Under PART 1, Public Water System, Section 102. Rate Schedule, of the Code of the Borough of Wyalusing, hereby *adds* the following:

B. Water Rates. Water usage shall be billed at the following rates:

- (1) All consumers (residential, multi-unit, commercial, industrial, retail, or non-residential) shall be billed at the rate of \$0.005 per gallon with the 4,000 gallon per month minimum charge (\$20 per month per consumer).
- (2) Residential Apartment buildings will be charged the 4,000 gallon minimum for each unit.

E. Delegation to the Authority. The Borough of Wyalusing delegates to the Wyalusing Municipal Authority the power to regulate the water rates, including increasing or decreasing said rates as deemed appropriate by the Wyalusing Municipal Authority. Furthermore, the Borough delegates to the Authority the power to collect the water accounts and to institute legal action to collect delinquent accounts, and the power to file municipal liens as required. Furthermore, the Borough of Wyalusing authorizes the Wyalusing Municipal Authority to increase or decrease said rates by resolution of the Authority at a duly advertised Authority meeting. Said water rate increase shall be subject to approval by resolution of the Borough of Wyalusing Council at a duly advertised Council meeting. Said Borough Resolution for water rate increase shall be adopted prior to the Authority implementing a water rate increase.

This ordinance shall take effect as of June 1, 2014.
