**Treasurer's Report:** VanDeMark made the motion to pay the bills as presented seconded by Dietz. The motion was carried unanimously by voice vote. The Treasurer's Report was reviewed by Council members. The President accepted the report and it was filed for audit.

- (5) Penn Dot paving of 706 blocked Storm Drains – had to clean out.
- (6) Street sweeping being held off until after Carnival in July

  - b. Need boulders placed, so people do not drive on walking path.
  - c. Bruce Lawn Care presented new bid for mowing Creekside Park. Motion was made by VanDeMark and seconded by Dietz to accept new bid. The motion was carried 3 to 1 by voice vote.
  - d. WMA needs to mow/trim around pump house.
  - e. Benches being ordered & Park Grills delivered
  - f. Endless Mountain Heritage awarded Borough \$10,000 grant for the park.
- (2) Update on Spring Clean Up & E-recycle event May 14, 2022 – went well
- (3) Riverside Drive Paving – waiting on drain culverts to come in. Bishop’s will not start until after carnival in July
- (4) A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Dietz to have Dave Burgess restore totem pole from Fountain Park and reinstall it on RT 6 with the other totem pole he has restored. The motion was carried unanimously by voice vote.
