FIREARMS AND FIREWORKS

BOROUGH OF WYALUSING
ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE CHAPTER NO. 9, FIREARMS AND FIREWORKS, OF
THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WYALUSING, COUNTY OF BRADFORD,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to regulate Firearms as authorized under the Borough Code found at 53 P.S. § 46202, Specific powers.

(4) Nuisances. To prohibit and remove any obstruction or nuisance in the streets of the borough.

(23) Dangerous and inflammable articles, substances and materials. To prohibit the manufacture, sale or storage of inflammable or otherwise dangerous articles, substances or materials; to prescribe the quantities of any such articles, substances or materials that may be kept in any location and/or building; and to prescribe such other safeguards as may be necessary.

The Borough of Wyalusing hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

§ 1. SALE OF FIREWORKS UNLAWFUL.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to detonate, sell, offer for sale, detonate, or have in his, her or its possession or custody for the purpose of sale any toy pistol, squib, skyrocket, firecracker, roman candle, fire balloon or other combustible fireworks or any article for the making of a pyrotechnic display in the Borough of Wyalusing except sparklers.
- B. A civic organization may apply to the Borough Council for a permit for a firework display provided they meet the necessary requirements from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and have sufficient liability insurance as established by the Borough Council.
- C. A civic organization may apply to the Borough Council for a permit to use an approved starter pistol for a sporting event.

§ 2. DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS RESTRICTED.

No person shall fire any gun, pistol, BB Gun, air gun, pellet gun, and/or paint ball gun within the limits of the Borough of Wyalusing except in the Agricultural District and except for authorized law enforcement officials in the discharge of their official duties.

§3. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

Any person, firm or corporation who or which shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600 and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, be imprisoned for a term not exceeding 30 days.

THIS ORDINANCE shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
